Homeless Liaison Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Homeless children and youths are identified by school personnel through outreach and coordination with other agencies.
- 2. Homeless children and youths are enrolled in, and have a full and equal opportunity to succeed in, school
- 3. Homeless families, children, and youths have access to and receive educational services for which they are eligible.
- 4. Homeless families, children, and youths receive referrals to health care services, dental services, mental health and substance abuse services and other appropriate services.
- 5. The parents or guardians of homeless children and youths are informed of the educational and other opportunities available to their families.
- 6. Public notice of the educational rights of homeless children and youths is disseminated in locations frequented by parents or guardians of homeless children and youths, including schools, shelters, and public libraries in a form understandable to parents and guardians.
